

Updated Instructions for Parking Lot Service:

- The governor's announcement for houses of worship, this relates to us, we wanted to update you on how this relates to our church.
 - You can sit outside your car during the service; we ask that everyone sit on the driver's side of their own car. Bring a comfortable chair and remove your mask as long as you have social distance. Don't forget sunscreen, it can get hot.
 - We will still have a parking lot Sunday service as planned – **WHY?**
 1. The restrictions put us in an unworkable bldg situation
 2. The restrictions do not allow for childcare
 3. We are making decisions based on the danger of the virus and protection for the larger vulnerable population of our church community
 - Our biblical mandate for peoples care *overrides* the legal allowance for church operation
 4. Pastor Randy has mentioned our parking lot and the advantages of its size and benefit of outdoor services – now is the time take advantage of it.
 5. Until Mass restrictions make it more functional for us, we will continue to have services in the parking lot
- Please arrive at least **15 minutes early** for the Service so there is time to park all the cars before we start – **begins at 10am.**
 - Follow the ushers direction for parking in front of cones and lining up each car behind the initial front row car

- **TUNE YOUR RADIO** station to either **FM 87.9 or 90.1** - these are low frequency stations and only extend to the limits of our parking lot.
- Please keep your windows up so the broadcast isn't stepping on the car next to you and there isn't an echo of the sound.
- **BATHROOMS** will be open for use:
 - **Adult** men's and women's bathrooms will be accessible through the **bookstore entrance** door on the right front of the building, doors will be opened for you. **Please:**
 - Line up outside the building 6 feet apart
 - A mask is **REQUIRED** to enter the building
 - No more than 2 people will be allowed in the bathroom
 - Ushers will direct people and be available outside the bathrooms if there in any issue
 - **Children** will have access to kid's bathrooms through the CCA School doors on the **left front** of the building.
 - Adults are asked to accompany their children and wait for them.
 - A mask is **REQUIRED** for children over 5 years old
 - No more than 2 children or a parent and child in a bathroom at the same time
 - Ushers will direct people to the bathroom
- **OFFERING**, *(if you don't use EasyTithe or US mail)* will be collected at the beginning of the service for those who desire to give. You will be instructed to put your lights on and someone will walk by your car to collect your offering to the Lord. ***Please make sure it is in an envelope with your name on it.***

- **EXITING**, initially we were going to have the rear gate opened for exiting the parking lot. However, we will be exiting all cars out the front of the parking lot. Please follow the ushers direction.
- **FELLOWSHIP**, if you desire to remain in the parking lot after the service and fellowship, please wait until all the cars that are leaving have exited before you wander around the parking lot. You must remain the 6 foot social distance requirement during this time. The building will be closed and bathrooms unavailable after the service ends.
- **Finally** remember if it is going to rain, there will not be a Sunday service in the parking lot.
- **Each Saturday** we will post information on whether or not church service is on for the following day through; [Instagram](#), [Facebook](#), the front page of our [website](#) and on the *church phone*, informing whether there is a church service.
- *Additionally*, Pastor Scott Greenberg will also send out an email to the people who have given him their email addresses to let them know if there will be a Sunday service.
